## **THE SYDNEY EHRMAN FELLOWSHIP for 2008-2009**

**Who may apply?**

The fellowship is open to students in any field of study who wish to study at King's College in Cambridge.

**Eligibility Requirements:**

- Must have a bachelor's or master's degree from UC Berkeley (the degree must be completed before the beginning of the fall semester)  
~OR~ have a bachelor's degree from Yale University.
- Be in good academic standing.

**Award:**

\$15,000 stipend per semester

**Additional Information:**

- The award is for \$30,000 for study at King's College.
- Students do not need to provide proof of admittance to King's College at the time the application is submitted.
- Students who receive the fellowship must provide evidence that they will attend King's College before leaving in the fall.
- This is not a campus exchange program. Students must apply separately to King's College for admission.
- Students who have completed their PhD program are not eligible. The fellowship cannot be used as a post-doc.
- The number of awards has not been determined and will depend on the pool of applicants.
